Pristine lakes, rugged mountain peaks, and towering forests older than mankind make this dramatic landscape impossible to ignore. Cradle Mountain Lodge is a unique and contemporary wilderness retreat on the edge of the World Heritage Listed Cradle Mountain-Lake St. Clair National Park. Here, ancient mountain peaks and trees thousands of years old are reflected in mirror-like lakes and each season brings new delights to enjoy. Days are filled with simple pleasures, including sampling fine Tasmanian food and wine.

accommodation

Total of 86 timber cabins set in the wilderness all featuring:

- Wood or Gas Fire • Electric Heater in King Billy & Spa Suites only • Alarm Clock • Private facilities with toilet, shower & amenities • Table and Chairs • Tea & Coffee making facilities • Mini-Bar • Hairdryers • Iron & Ironing Board • Serviced daily

To help guests leave the outside world behind, televisions whilst available in the Lodge, are not found in guest cabins.

King Billy Suite

Representing the ultimate in wilderness accommodation, King Billy Suites are spacious, featuring separate sleeping and living areas including king size bed and oversized bathroom with spa. The interior highlights a contemporary design scheme with premium appointments. Outdoors, a large deck area includes a private hot-tub. Spa Suite

Each Spa Suite has a private verandah. Styled with hand-made Tasmanian wood furnishings, each features a king size bed, log fire and deep spa.

Cradle Mountain Lodge is located 81 km from Devonport (1¼ hrs), 110 km from Burnie (1½ hrs), 142 km from Launceston (2½ hrs) and 375 km from Hobart (4½ hrs). Allow additional travelling time during adverse conditions.

climate

The weather in this alpine region is changeable and unpredictable, but if you are well prepared for it you will enjoy the many moods of the mountain and rainforests. Average maximum temperatures: Summer 18°C (68°F), Winter 6°C (42°F).

what to bring

Warm clothing, walking shoes and socks, camera and binoculars, waterproof coats and swimwear for The Sanctuary. Raincoats can be hired from reception whilst gumboots are available for hire from the Lodge Store.
